	the grade will be lowered by -2. If an assignment gets more than a 40% match it will not be graded. The assignment will get a zero, without the opportunity to hand in again. 3. Your assignments must include citations and a bibliography (APA) to be considered complete. 4. Your assignments must be handed in through Turnitin in INNA. You must respect the due dates. 5. Late assignments can at the most get the grade 5. We will have two „stop-posts“ during the semester. After each of these, previous assignments will not be accepted.

Digital literacy and media literacy are practiced through a variety of project types and the use of diverse text types.
